## **Women and Children**

Coast Shelter offers accommodation and support for single women and women with accompanying children. Our three crisis refuges provide supportive and caring accommodation where women can begin to rebuild their lives. Safety and security is ensured, enabling women to come to terms with any trauma caused by domestic or family violence.

We utilise a number of 'exit houses' in partnership with community housing providers giving women the opportunity to gain a positive rental history before moving into their own tenancy. Staff will assist women to find

suitable permanent accommodation and develop the necessary living skills to maintain their own accommodation.
