Women and Children

Coast Shelter offers accommodation and support for single women and women with accompanying children. Our three crisis refuges provide supportive and caring accommodation where women can begin to rebuild their lives. Safety and security is ensured, enabling women to come to terms with any trauma caused by domestic or family violence.

We utilise a number of 'exit houses' in partnership with community housing providers giving women the opportunity to gain a positive rental history before moving into their own tenancy. Staff will assist women to find suitable permanent accommodation and develop the necessary living skills to maintain their own accommodation.

Young People

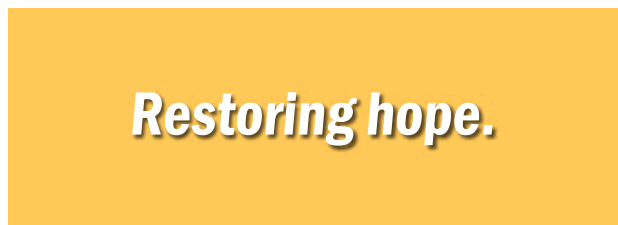
Coast Shelter offers temporary accommodation for young people aged between 16 and 25. Our five youth refuges provide young people with the support and guidance to get their lives back on track.

All young people are assisted to develop the necessary personal attributes and living skills to sustain a tenancy.

Each refuge operates as a shared household and residents work together to carry out household responsibilities, organise meals, do grocery shopping and plan activities such as weekend outings.

Coast Community Centre

The Community Centre provides free meals and support services to help homeless, vulnerable, financially disadvantaged and socially isolated community members. The Community Centre also offers the following free services:

- Meals
- Food hampers
- Energy vouchers (EAPA)
- Doorways 'Housing Connector'
- Shower and laundry facilities
- Toiletries, towels and clothing

Other services available periodically or by appointment:

- No Interest Loans (NILS)
- Legal advice
- Centrelink assistance
- Podiatry checkups

Men

Coast Shelter offers temporary accommodation for single men in Gosford and Wyong. Staff work with men to identify their needs and set goals to help them find permanent accommodation and achieve self-reliance.

Staff collaborate with other local support services to obtain additional assistance so that men can address any issues which may have led to their homelessness.
